SEAB and Limak Preliminary Deal to Build 70 kb/d Oil Refinery

Iraq signed a preliminary agreement with Swedish SEAB and Turkey's Limak to build a 70 kb/d refinery near the northern city of Mosul. The facility is expected to use complex and advanced techniques to process

Qayarah oilfield's heavy crude oil into clean products that comply with Euro V standards. The estimated cost of the project was not disclosed. SEAB and Limak are expected to present the financial and technical plans for the oil refinery in the next three months.

SEAB has been working in Iraq on oil recovery, soil remediation and water treatment projects. The country has been aiming to boost its refinery capacity from almost 875 kb/d to 1.5 Mb/d.
