Akkas Gas Development

Iraq is negotiating with US Halliburton for the Akkas Gas development, part of the country's strategy to increase non-associated gas output to 2.7 Bcf/d in 2025, from the current 1.5 Bcf/d. Akkas field was discovered in 1992 and has estimated non-associated gas reserves of around 5.6 Tcf, at the western Anbar

Province, bordering Iran. The Akkas development has been delayed for many years due to local insecurity, according to the Oil Ministry Undersecretary Hamid Al Zawbaei. It is also technically challenging.
