CPECC to build large gas processing plant in Nassirya

- China Petroleum Engineering and Construction Co. (CEPCC), part of state-owned CNPC, was awarded
 a contract by Baker Hughes to carry out the engineering for 200 Mcf/d of associated gas from the
 Nassirya and Al-Gharraf fields for power generation. Once complete, the plant will significantly lower
 fuel costs for Iraq's gas-fired power plants in the region while reducing gas flaring.
- CEPCC was previously awarded a US\$ 1.07 B contract to build and operate facilities to process 300 Mcf/d of associated gas at the giant Halfaya oilfield in 2019. Contractors have completed 51% of the planned gas processing plant at Halfaya, with start-up scheduled in mid-2023. Previously, it was expected to be completed by end-2022.
